## ALIBI

- A claim or piece of evidence that one was elsewhere when an act, typically a criminal one, is alleged to have taken place:
- Your alibi is evidence that proves your innocence. If you were making cookies with your mom when someone raided your sister's piggy bank, your mom is your *alibi*, since she knows you were with her when the crime was committed.

## ALIEN

- being or from or characteristic of another place or part of the world
- Something that's alien is different or foreign. In science fiction, space *aliens* come from other planets. In reality, illegal *aliens* come from other countries.

## ALIENATE

- arouse hostility or indifference in where there had formerly been love, affection, or friendliness
- When you alienate people, you make them stop liking or caring about you.

## INALIENABLE

- incapable of being repudiated or transferred to another
- Something that is yours forever, that can't be taken away and given to your little brother instead? That something would be called inalienable. The word refers to a natural right that cannot be revoked by an outside force.

- any of several different crystalline forms of the same chemical compound
- “*calcium carbonate occurs in the allomorphs calcite and aragonite*”

## PARALLEL

- being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting
- *parallel* means similar, or happening at the same time. A story might describe the *parallel* lives of three close friends.

- a short moral story (often with animal characters)
- The figurative style known as allegory has nothing to do with alligators — unless you're telling a story where alligators represent evil forces snapping at humanity

## ALLERGY

- hypersensitivity reaction to a particular allergen; symptoms can vary greatly in intensity
- An allergy is a physical reaction to some specific food or substance. If you have an allergy to cats, they'll make you itchy and swollen no matter how much you love to pet them.

- the usual method of treating disease with remedies that produce effects differing from those produced by the disease itself

- elevation especially above sea level or above the earth's surface

- an instrument that measures the height above ground; used in navigation

### alter ego

## AMBIENT

- Ambient is an adjective used to describe an aspect of the environment that completely surrounds you, but in a mellow way, like *ambient* music played softly throughout a restaurant, or the *ambient* orange glow during a setting sun.

## AMBIVALENCE

- mixed feelings or emotions
- Someone who shows ambivalence about a person or thing has conflicting feelings. If you love your mom but find her totally embarrassing, you might feel *ambivalent* about having her give a presentation at your school.

- a particular environment or surrounding influence
- An *ambiance* is the mood or setting of a place. You might like the *ambiance* of a certain restaurant because the lighting and decor makes you feel comfortable and happy.

- a person has ambition, the goal is usually wealth, power, or fame.

### AMPLITUDE

- greatness of magnitude
- Amplitude describes something there is a lot of, or abundance.

### AMPLIFY

- increase in size, volume or significance

Root : ANDR

Meaning : ( man )

### ANDROGYNOUS

- having both male and female characteristics

### MISANDRY

- Hating males

Root : ANDR

Meaning : ( man )

androphobia

□ a morbid fear of men

polyandry

□ Having more than one husband

Root : ANX

Meaning : ( worried, distressed )

## ANXIETY

- (psychiatry) a relatively permanent state of worry and nervousness occurring in a variety of mental disorders, usually accompanied by compulsive behavior or attacks of panic

## ANXIOUS

- When you are anxious, you are very concerned or worried, but it can also refer to when you are quite interested in something. You might be *anxious* to improve your performance in math class after falling asleep during a big test.

Root : ANX

Meaning : ( worried, distressed )

### ANXIOLYTIC

- a tranquilizer used to relieve anxiety and reduce tension and irritability

### ANXIOUSNESS

- a feeling of mild anxiety about possible developments

Root : APERT

Meaning : ( open )

### APPARATUS

- equipment designed to serve a specific function

### APERTURE

- a natural opening in something
- an man-made opening; usually small

Root : APO

Meaning : ( away (prefix) )

## APOCALYPSE

- Apocalypse is a word that means "the end of the world" — or something so destructive it seems like the world has ended in a place, like a major earthquake.

## APOGEE

- For an object in orbit around the earth, the apogee is the point that is highest or furthest from the earth



Root : APO

Meaning : ( away (prefix) )

## APOLOGY

- An apology is what you say or do when you want to let someone know (or fool them into thinking) that you regret something.

Root : APT

Meaning : ( fit, join )

## APTITUDE

- inherent ability
- When you have a talent or do something well, people say that you have an *aptitude* for it.

## ADAPT

- the process of adapting to something (such as environmental conditions)

Root : APT

Meaning : ( fit, join )

### INEPT

- A clumsy, incompetent person — or an ineffective action — is inept.
- Inept people are dumb or clueless; they don't understand things. More than that, inept people are bad at what they do.

### ADEPT

- having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude

Root : ARCH

Meaning : ( rule, govern )

### ANARCHY

- a state of lawlessness and disorder (usually resulting from a failure of government)

### HIERARCHY

- a series of ordered groupings of people or things within a system

Root : ARCH

Meaning : ( rule, govern )

## MONARCH

- A *monarch*, such as a king or queen, rules a kingdom or empire.
- an autocracy governed by a monarch who usually inherits the authority

## PATRIARCH

- the male head of family or tribe

Root : ARCH

Meaning : ( rule, govern )

## OLIGARCHY

- a political system governed by a few people

Root : ARCHAEO

Meaning : ( ancient, OLD )

### ARCHAEOLOGIST

- An archaeologist is a scientist who studies human history by digging up human remains and artifacts.

### ARCHAIC

- so extremely old as seeming to belong to an earlier period
